P COIMBRA01:

Master students need to send a bachelor certificate OR a transcript of records with 180 ECTS credits to the Student Exchange Office.

PhD students need to send a master certificate to the Student Exchange Office. PhD students will only receive ECTS credits if they complete courses at the host institution. Therefore, they will not receive any ECTS credits from the host institution for PhD-related research they undertake. The home institution is responsible for accrediting PhD students with ECTS credits for research completed at the host institution.

It is not possible for students to hand-in their final BA-/MA-/PhD-thesis at the host institution. Final theses need to be graded by the home institution.

The University of Colmbra offers counseling for students with disabilities and chronic diseases. - 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **5 weeks** after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

This agreement shall remain in force until the end of the Programme (2020/21). However, in the event of unliateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
