The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus⁺ programme. This Inter-institutional agreement will come into effect only in the event that both institutions are holders of valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for the period mentioned above and they commit to respect the quality requirements of ECHE in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility. If the Erasmus⁺ programme sets extra criteria, this Agreement will be reviewed.

P LISBOA109 – Information for incoming exchange students

- 1 Exchange students will meet the admission requirements of the host university in terms of prerequisites for courses and language proficiency.
- 2 The host university will provide Reception Days for incoming students.
- 3 Exchange students are entitled to the same rights and privileges as students normally enrolled at the host university, except for the right for graduation.
- 4 The host university will comply with all relevant health and safety regulations of the host country for incoming exchange students.

- 2. The receiving institutions will send their decisions within 6-8 weeks after deadline.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of this Agreement or Changes in the data set above can be amended annually, if communicated before January 1st. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

 - All documents must be submitted online. No hard copies are needed.
- 2- Técnico sends by mail notification on admission automatically within 5 weeks.
- 3- Técnico only sends Acceptance Letters to students that need Visa.
- 4- The host university will issue a Transcript of Records no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished.
- Termination of the agreement

 If one or both parties wish to terminate the agreement a notice period of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

 In the event that notice of termination of the agreement is given, students who have already been selected and accepted for the exchange programme may still participate. Notwithstanding the termination of the agreement, each institution agrees that it will continue to fulfil its responsibilities to Exchange Students already registered at their institution until the completion of their particular exchange period.
