- 2. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 3. Termination of the agreement

In the event of termination or amendment of this agreement by either party notice will be given by October of the preceding year. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 October 2015 will only take effect as of 1 October 2016. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

1. Grading systems of the institutions

F PARISO04

At Paris-Sorbonne University, all our marks are out of 20. For information, Paris-Sorbonne stands amongst one the most difficult grading systems in France. It is important to notice that a 10/20 is a good grade, and that it stands for the passing grade.

The credit part refers to the number of European credits the course provides. It is based on the 30 credits per semester system that French students must pass to validate one semester. It does not refer to the number of hours taken for one course. The local grade (/20) is the most relevant information you should consider to validate your students' semester/year at Paris-Sorbonne.

Please note that when local grade is "attented" or "enrolled", it means that your student attended the class and provide the necessary work for it, but did not take any exams.
