This Inter-institutional agreement will come into effect only in the event that both institutions are holders of valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for the period mentioned above and they commit to respect the quality requirements of ECHE in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility. If the Erasmus⁺ programme sets extra criteria this Agreement will be reviewed.

Hochschule Zittau/Görlitz grading system

The grading scheme comprises five to six levels (with numerical equivalents; intermediate grades may be given):

grade '1' (sehr gut - 1.0 to 1.5): very good, outstanding achievement;

grade '2' (gut - 1.6 to 2.5): good achievement, which lies substantially above average;

grade '3' (befriedigend - 2.6 to 3.5): satisfactory achievement, meets average requirements;

grade '4' (ausreichend - 3.6 to 4.0): sufficient achievement, meets requirements;

grade '5' (nicht ausreichend / nicht bestanden - 4.1-5.0): not sufficient / failed, achievement does not meet the requirements.

The minimum passing grade is '4' (ausreichend). If the final average grade achieved is 1.2, 1.1 or 1.0, students are awarded a special distinction which is called *mit Auszeichnung bestanden* and means 'excellent performance'.

In addition, students may have to work on various types of assignments (*Vorleistung* or *Testat*). These assignments are usually not graded, or the grades are without relevance to the module grades. However, *Vorleistungen* or *Testate* have to be performed successfully as they are a precondition to proceed with one's studies.

Statistical distribution of grades according to the description in the ECTS users' guide is usually specified in the final Transcript of Records.

⁹ The sending and receiving institutions will provide assistance in obtaining insurance for incoming and outbound mobile participants, according to the requirements of the ECHE. The receiving institution will inform mobile participants of cases in which insurance cover is not automatically provided.
