3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination of the agreement: The present bilateral agreement will be valid during the academic years **2014/15 – 2019/20**, unless either side terminates the agreement in writing at the latest by September 30th for activities taking place during the next (n+1) academic year. Additional activities, cancellations or new subject areas are to be communicated by the same deadline. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held in case of a conflict.


