- **E3.** A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving institution.
- **E4.** This agreement will come into effect from the date of signature by the partner universities. It remains valid until the end of the final academic year indicated on page 1 of the present agreement or until the partners agree to end it by mutual accord, provided that a minimum of one academic year's notice is given. Should a single partner wish to withdraw from the agreement prior to the validity period indicated in page 1, that institution must guarantee that any student admitted at that time will be able to continue their studies and complete the planned mobility.
